




- Move the rear seat cushion forwards
- 1. Take the courtesy light out of its housing, then disconnect the electrical coonnections and remove it.






1. Using tool **1.823.014.000**, release the rear roof panel trim from the plastic nails and remove it.






- 1. Remove the plastic cap.

1. Remove the two "heel boards" (see specific paragraph).




- 1. Carefully remove part of the door seal.
- 2. Using tool 1.823.014.000 prise the pillar cover towards the inside of the car and remove it.






1. Slacken and remove the screw fastening the pretensioning device "safety" bracket.




1. Separate the inner bracket from the retainer pin on the innertia reel to "disable" the pretensioner, then remove it from the pillar.



1. Through the special window make sure that the security device has been engaged checking that the spring shown by the arrow has returned to the rest position (towards the inside of the car); if not, suspend the procedure and be very careful because the device may be triggered.


NOTE: when the inner bracket is in position its tooth presses on the spring causing the release of the security device.








FRONT SEAT BEL HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT DEVICE

- 2. Using tool 1.823.013.000, remove the front heelboard.



- 1. Slacken the two screws fastening the courtesy light support.




1. Release the courtesy light using a screwdriver in the two notches on the frame to free the catches, disconnect the electrical connector and remove the light.

1. Lower the rear section of the roof panel trim enough to cut the glue as illustrated.




- Remove the roof panel trim.




When refitting the roof panel trim, reverse the sequence followed for removal and observing the instructions below.

1. Coat the roof panel trim and the roof panel with the specified glue in the area illustrated below.





1. Position the roof panel trim using guide pins 1.823.020.002 and 1.823.020.001, as illustrated and press it with the hands in the areas coated with glue.



1. Release and remove the sunroof seal.






- Remove the roof panel trim firstly moving it towards one side in order to release it from the other and retrieve it drawing it out through the front door.



When refitting make sure that on the roof panel trim there are all the seals illustrated and the clamps for the front fastening screws.







REAR BUMPER

REMOVAL


- Raise the car just enough to gain access to the side screw fastening the left-hand wheelhouse.
- 1. Slacken and remove the side screw fastening the left-hand wheelhouse.
- 2. Slacken and remove the upper wheelhouse fastening nuts (one for the left-hand wheelhouse and one for the right-hand wheelhouse).




- 1. Using ratchet wrench **1.822.132.000**, slacken and remove the four screws fastening the left-hand and right-hand wheelhouse to the bumper.
- 2. Prise and remove the wheelhouse; lower the car.



1. Prise the number plate lights and remove them after disconnecting the electrical connections.



- Remove the two rear luggage stay hooks.
- 1. Move aside the trim and slacken the four bumper fastening screws, two for each side.



1. Remove the bumper, pulling from the rear of the car.
